



WHAT IS THE NORTH MOUNTAIN HEALING CENTER?

- 100 beds in closed campus.
- Individuals convicted of a sexual offense are not eligible
- Placements by referral only; no "walk ups" permitted.
- Security on-site 24-7-365
- EMT on-site 24-7-365
- Around-the-clock staff will include a manager, supervisor and 4 or more behavioral health technicians






- Prioritized for individuals identified to be experiencing street homelessness in the Outreach Area of Interest
- Phoenix Police precinct prioritization
- Local Business prioritization
- Mental Health Treatment,
 Substance Use Treatment,
 Physical Health Services, Peer
 Support, Groups, Counseling
- Garden, Recreation Center, Workforce Development



CBI ENHANCED SHELTER THE DIFFERENCE

- Access to safe stable shelter to meet basic needs
- Connection to Integrated Care to address Physical Conditions, Mental Health, and Substance Use
- 1:25 Caseload Ratio for development of housing plan and ongoing case management until lease up
- Certified Peer Support Specialists
- 24/7 Access to Triage RN and Licensed Clinician
- CBI Outreach and Housing Continuum
- There is no service provider in the area doing this.






WE HEARD YOU AT THE MARCH LISTENING MEETING

- Crime and safety in the neighborhood near the Healing Center is a concern.




